I faced the same issues you talked about on this post. I spent some time digging around in code, and I have found the solution!

I am using:  
Joomla! 1.0.13 Stable  
Feed2post: 1.5

First I wrote code that limited the intro text to 1100 Characters. This prevents the intro text from being too long.

Then I set the variable to hide intro text from the Full text. (introtxt = 0)  
I also set the variable to show the authors name. (author=1)

I edited the file administrator/components/com\_feedpost/admin.feedpost.php  
line 450
