I wish to have a set intro (say, 3-4 lines) and a "Read More" button to take the reader to the full item.

How can I do that? Should I define something in the Joomla! definitions or somewhere in the Feed2Post configuration (I haven't found any such option).

Dear user, when configured to fetch a full text the main text should hold the content, and the intro text should only hold an intro, if you set the category/section to show only the intro it will display the "read more" link, if you set the category/section to hide that, it'll show the full content, from the f2p point of view, the content has been placed correctly... if you have a feed that has a lot of content in the intro, use the cut at tag feature and identify a tag that happens in all posts at some position, then you'll have the intro and main text splitted.
